Carondelet Village resident, Jo White, this month received the *President's Medal and Citation* from Saint John's University in celebration of her "life-long commitment and service to the world of calligraphy, and as the first and best supporter of *The Saint John's Bible*." The letter Jo received, informing her that Saint John's wanted to present her with this honor, states: "Through your devotion to the calligraphic arts, you met Donald Jackson, developed a friendship with him, and introduced him to Saint John's. Donald talked first to you about his dream to hand-write the Bible, and you became key to the relationship that resulted in the 'magnificent splendor' of *The Saint John's Bible*. Indeed, without your encouragement and support as the mother of *The Saint John's Bible*, this masterpiece may never have become a reality." Donald Jackson, long-time scribe to Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth's Crown Office, who spent seven years collaborating with artist-calligraphers, illuminators, scholars and the monks of Saint John's Abbey to create the first handwritten Bible since the invention of the printing press, wrote: "Jo has always been a champion of Saint John's and of *The Saint John's Bible* and she has reached out to the wider world to share her faith in us all. It can truly be said that for more than forty years Jo has been acknowledged as a formidable ambassador for western calligraphy and the lettering arts. *The Saint John's Bible* is one of the fruits of her energy. But it is to Saint John's and *The Saint John's Bible* she has always given her heart."
